Why Flies?

Flies have a much deeper impact on us than most people realize. They are:

- **decomposers** breaking down organic matter to recycle nutrients back to soil

- agricultural pests that consume fruits, leaves, stems and roots, or harm livestock and other animals
- disease vectors carrying fly-specific microorganisms that cause our most devastating diseases such as malaria, Zika, West Nile fever, and many more
- carriers of **food contaminants** that can cause illness
